

2019 APS Seed Distribution Program

Welcome to the APS's Seed Distribution Program (SDP). Thanks to all of the SDP donors for their generous donations, which make the program a success by providing a wide selection of seed to peony enthusiasts around the world. Over the past several years there has been a large increase in the interest in this program with many packets being sold, not only through the APS website, but also at the APS National Convention.

The SDP is a great opportunity for APS members to obtain a wide variety of seeds, without having to spend years growing the parent plants and waiting for them to produce seeds. At the same time you will be helping to support APS goals. I encourage the APS membership to experience the joy of creating something new, through purchase of at least a few packages of seed and planting them. One of your seedlings grown from this seed could turn out to be a Gold Medal winner—only your efforts and time will tell.

As of this writing, we have seed donations from 15 APS members. Our members donated seeds that came from a large selection of different pod parents. In addition, donations included of nice variety of peony seed mixes. Many of these seeds have genes from peony varieties that are not readily available from other sources.

Thanks go to Nate Bremer, owner of Solaris Farms, for his generous donation of some of the hand pollinated crosses that he made. Nate is a huge supporter of hybridizers and the SDP wanted the APS membership to benefit from his efforts. I'm sure those seeds will be in very high demand, so make sure to place your order as soon as possible. In addition, Nate has donated a nice selection of hybrid seeds from a number of varieties and seedlings which are not readily available.

Thanks also go to Harvey Buchite, owner of Hidden Springs Flower Farm, and Roy Klehm, owner of Klehm's Song Sparrow Farm and Nursery, for allowing me to collect seeds for the SDP from their fields. Don Hollingsworth has generously donated a mixture of early hybrid seed from his excellent collection. Jan DeRousse donated a wide variety of seeds, including a nice selection of tree peony seeds, herbaceous peony seeds from registered varieties and a number of seeds from her personal seedlings. In addition, to the preceding donors, I would like to thank all of the APS members which donated seeds to APS's 2019 SDP, your efforts are essential to the success of the program.

All packets are labelled with the seed parent's name and parentage, if available. Donors sometimes supply further details that may be included. In most cases these are open-pollinated seeds, meaning the pollen parent is unknown. The pollen could be from the seed parent or any of the peonies growing in the donor's garden or nearby. Thus, the resulting seedlings may bloom in a variety of flower forms and colors.

- \$2.00 per pack for lactiflora seeds (10–50 seeds per pack)
- \$2.00 per pack for hybrid seeds (5–25 seeds per pack)
- \$2.50 per pack for all species seeds (5–15 seeds per pack)
- \$2.50 per pack for all tree peony seeds - p. suffruticosa & p. rockii/gansu mudan (5–15 seeds per pack)
- \$5.00 per pack for Hand Pollinated seed crosses (5 seeds per pack)
* NOTE: There is a one pack limit, for each APS member, for the Hand Pollinated seed cross.
- \$6.00 flat fee for United States and Canadian orders

- 4) When your order has been confirmed, you will have two (2) business days to pay for the seeds. Do not pay until your order has been confirmed!
